

## Digital Photography – Image Prep for Web Portfolio

You should select your best examples for the following required shots:

- *2 Shutter Speed Photos (slow vs. fast shutter speed of same moving subject)*
- *2 White Balance Photos (correct vs. incorrect white balance of same subject)*
- *3 Exposure Photos (1 under-exposed, 1 over-exposed, 1 correct exposure - same subject/lighting)*
- *2 Depth of Field Photos (shallow vs. deep depth of field photos of same subject) - MUST USE MANUAL FOCUS!*
- *2 Rule of Thirds Photos*
- *2 Unique Angle/Composed Photos*
- *2 Shots Working With Natural Light/Shadow/Backlight*
- *4 Product Photos: 2 reflective objects, 2 non-reflective (use of lighting kit and no lighting kit)*
- *4 Portrait Photos (1 fluorescent, 1 point, 2 point and 3 point lighting schemes of same person/subject)*

Save your selections into a folder, then resize each selection as a 700 x 500 jpeg image.

You can use Adobe Bridge: Tools > Photoshop > Image Processor

Create a simple Word document for, and for each shot list the following :

- Image Name
- Shot Type/Subject
- F-stop
- Shutter Speed
- ISO
- Camera / Lens (if available)

*Example:*

Image #1  
Fast Shutter Speed  
F2.8  
1/2000 sec  
ISO 200  
D90 55-300

This information should all be available in Photoshop if you failed to log the shots accurately. Save this file for use in the upcoming Flash unit.
